Non-WSP EXHIBITION PROSPECTUS

Non-WSP ELIGIBILITY

The intention of this exhibiting level is intended to provide beginning/developing exhibitors that do not wish to compete at the WSP judging competition but would like to have their exhibit evaluated by a WSP-qualified judge to gain feedback in alignment with the Exhibit Evaluation Form (EEF). An annotated feedback form will be provided. Feedback for any Non-WSP will be provided at the frames but will not be included in the Judges Feedback Session.

1. Any exhibitor is eligible to enter **ONE** single **OR** multi-frame exhibit by conforming to these rules and regulations. All exhibits must be entered on the official entry form or a copy thereof.
2. All material must be the property of the exhibitor or of members of an immediate family living in the same household.
3. Exhibitor's names shall not appear on the faces of pages, though names and addresses are permissible on covers.
4. The exhibitor must be in attendance at the Rocky Mountain Stamp show. **No mail-in exhibits are allowed**

EXHIBITS

1. Frames -- Frames hold sixteen 8.5" x 11" pages. Larger pages will be accepted upon written request to the Exhibits Coordinator. Each page must be consecutively numbered on the back and must be placed within a transparent cover, preferably closed on two sides and the bottom.
2. A maximum of 40 frames has been reserved for Non-WSP entries. Acceptance will be on a first-completed entry basis.
3. Entry Fees - All exhibits are \$7.50 per frame. Junior exhibitors (age 21 or younger as of January 1, 2025) may exhibit free of charge provided the exhibit is a minimum of one frame (16 - 8.5"x11" pages). Failure to exhibit after notification of the exhibit's acceptance will result in forfeiture of the entry fee. Completed entry forms with payment attached, payable to ROMPEX, must be received by the Exhibits Coordinator by April 15, 2025. Should exhibit frames be sold out before that date, entry fees will be returned. A youth exhibitor's parent or guardian must also sign the youth's entry form. The Exhibits Coordinator reserves the right to reject any exhibit in whole or in part, in which case entry fees will be refunded.

Note on Future WSP Entry – RMSS will credit the reduced frame fee to the exhibitor if the subject exhibit is entered as a WSP Competitive exhibit at the RMSS show in the following year.

4. Title/Introductory Page and Synopsis -- Exhibitors must send a copy of their synopsis (no more than 2 pages) and introductory or title page (and exhibit plan for thematic exhibits), with their completed entry form. Electronic submission using **PDF FORMAT ONLY**, is required – do not send Jpegs or other formats. **An entry received without a synopsis/title page will not be accepted until the synopsis and title page is received and fees paid.** These pages may be preliminary.
5. Delivery of Exhibits – Exhibits must be personally delivered to the Arapahoe County Fairgrounds, 25690 E Quincy Ave, Aurora, CO 80016 between 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 22, 2025. Exhibitors who prefer to use other means should make arrangements with the Exhibits Coordinator.
6. Return of Exhibits -- No exhibit will be removed from the frames until the exhibit area has been cleared of all visitors after the exhibition closes at **3:00** p.m. on Sunday, May 25, 2025. Exhibits must be picked up by 5:00 p.m.

JUDGING, AWARDS and Seminar

No awards are presented to Non-WSP exhibits

General Class --For those exhibitors who wish to compete for the Non-WSP awards must provide exhibits from a minimum of two to a maximum of ten frames each.

Exhibit sub-classes within the General Class -- 1) Advertising, Patriotic, Event Covers, 2) Aerophilately, 3) Astrophilately, 4) Cinderella, 5) Display, 6) Experimental, 7) First Day Covers, 8) Maximaphily, 9) Picture Postcard, 10) Postal History, 11) Postal Stationery, 12) Revenue, 13) Thematic, 14) Topical, and 15) Traditional.

One-Frame Class -- These exhibits will be judged separately from multi-frame exhibits.

An, "At-the-Frames" evaluation will be provided by a WSP-qualified judge. This is a verbal review presented in the format of the WSP Exhibit Evaluation Form.

Rocky Mountain Stamp Show Non-World Series of Philately (Non-WSP) Exhibit Evaluation

The Colorado show will be offering an opportunity for beginning/novice-level exhibitors to put up an exhibit at the show for the purpose of evaluation by a team of experienced exhibitors and APS certified judges.

The intent of this special category is to provide suggestions for improvement and refinement of an exhibitor's work prior to entry as a competitive exhibit at the WSP level.

Exhibits may be single or multi-frame. An accompanying exhibiting seminar will be presented during the show. This exhibiting category is an, "**Attendance Only**" event with no mail-in exhibits accepted. The show has allocated a maximum of 40 frames to this event on a first-entry-completed basis.

No awards are presented for this category. However, each participant will receive "At-the-Frames" judges feedback Form and recognition of participation at the awards banquet. Evaluation of said exhibits will be performed by qualified APS judges who will give evaluations based upon standard judging criteria.

Stamp Club Single-Frame Entries

The Rocky Mountain Stamp Show presents an opportunity for any club to present a single frame exhibit to be judged on the basis of, "**Which exhibit best represents the activities of the Club's philatelic focus**".

The sixteen pages submitted can be in any format with matching page styles not required. **The intent is for club members to submit individual pages to create the Club's storyline.**

This exhibiting category is an, "**Attendance Only**" event with no mail-in exhibits accepted. A member of each club must put up and take down the Club's exhibit.

In 2024, the Cherrelyn Stamp Club won the best presentation award out of 12 club entries. Past winners have included the Cyber Stamp Club (Youth), Great Britain and Commonwealth Club, The Colorado Postal History Society, the Collectors Club of Denver and the Scandinavian Collectors Club.

The award is placed on a plaque at the Rocky Mountain Philatelic Library and the plaque is shown at the show next to the Club entries. Recognition of the participating clubs and this year's winner will be made at the awards banquet.
